

Mayor Coleman Announces New Cub Foods Store on East Side

Development project to create over 200 jobs

(Saint Paul) – Saint Paul Mayor Chris Coleman today announced the arrival of a new Cub Foods store in Phalen Village on the East Side of Saint Paul. Mayor Coleman was joined by Councilmember Dan Bostrom, Paul Tucci of Oppidan, Eileen-Lund Johnson of North End East Neighborhoods Development and the president of Cub Foods, Brian Huff.

“The opening of a Cub Foods is a boost for the East Side and all of Saint Paul,” said Mayor Coleman. “This is a prime location for a new grocery store, and it will bring good-paying jobs to the neighborhood. I thank Cub Foods and all of our partners for making this project a reality.”

The project will create up to 130 full and part-time jobs paying above the living wage at the Cub Foods store and 80 construction jobs. The 60,000 square foot supermarket will include grocery, a bank, a pharmacy and 14,000 square feet of general neighborhood commercial space. The estimated market value of the development is \$15,000,000.
