

Mayor Chris Coleman welcomes Cray Inc. Employees to Downtown on Wednesday, January 13, 2010. The ceremony is to celebrate the supercomputer company's move to Saint Paul.

Mayor Chris Coleman will join downtown business leaders and executives from Cray Inc. Wednesday to welcome the more-than-200 employees to downtown Saint Paul in a ceremony at Cray Plaza. In November, Cray moved its Midwest headquarters into the former Galtier Plaza, leasing more than 51,000 square feet in the iconic Lowertown highrise building. The move prompted a name change for the building.

Initially, Cray will employ 225 people in the Saint Paul location. The lease includes options for an additional 15,000 square feet of space as Cray grows in the supercomputer technology sector.
